

UFO sightings, lights reported in Pawhuska area

PAWHUSKA (AP) —Sightings of unidentified flying objects and of strange lights are being voiced in this northern Oklahoma community.

According to reports, objects with bright lights underneath have hovered five feet above the ground. There have been reports of unexplained lights in wooded areas where there shouldn't be houses or other sources of light.

Most of the reports have involved an area between Pawhuska and Nulogoney, about seven mile southeast of here.

An object with "a blinding white light and blinking bluish green and red lights" was reported on a freshly-plowed field near Nulogoney. Paul Kendricks of Tulsa, who was plowing a field at night for his father, said the object hovered just a few feet above the ground but left as he drove that way with his tractor.

Another couple to whom he reported the incident also saw a similar light.

Jack Watts, a well pumper from Pawhuska, reported observing objects from his back porch.

Mrs. Fay Roberts reported observing unexplained lights in the Osage Hills for a period of 15 years. She has not seen any objects, however.

Three staff members of the Pawhuska Journal-Capital went to the area at night with a camera, but did not see anything.
